Setup:

WM Time Needed:

10 min: review examples of geometric application in daily life and within the lodge

Member Time Needed

5-10 min: think about personal applications of geometry

Considerations:

Individuals in the lodge will participate in different ways. Challenging a member to participate in a way that is uncomfortable for them should only be done with a skilled facilitator and a high-trust group.

Messaging:

Most brothers see geometry as a tool for blueprints, not a mindset that reveals truth. By the close of this discussion, each brother should be able to name one way he misapplies geometry in his life and commit to changing it.

Key questions:

“What is geometry -- not the mathematical definition, but your actual working definition as a Mason?”

“Can we apply geometry to relationships, or is it only about spatial relations?”

“When does the lodge withhold the principle of geometry from brothers and why?”

“Where in your life do you struggle to see the whole system instead of individual parts?”

“What does a true master of geometry look like -- not in words, but in action?”

Wrap-up:

Touch on the key points and highlights of the discussion. Pay special attention to discoveries or immediate learnings by the participants. Personalize positive feedback with “I really valued Brother [John’s] point about X, or Y”
